Interns will help lead programs for all ages, work directly with live marine animals, teach outreach programs, and work on a variety of other programs and special events to promote Island Beach State Park. Interns work a minimum of 12 hrs/week, not to exceed 30 hrs/week. Weekends are required.

Responsibilities

Local Outreach Events
School Programs

Each intern will also work on one major project, such as creating a new publication, program or exhibit or developing a web page.

- Be working towards a degree in marine science, natural resource management, environmental studies, or related field.
- Possess a valid driver's license and personal vehicle.
- Ability to work well with others and independently.
- Have an interest in fieldwork and working in the outdoors.
